



Show Handling competition rules.

For Show Handlers under 13 years, 13 and 17 years, 18 and 40 years en over 40 years.

1. The entry form has to be filled in en signed by parents, guardian or responsible of the Junior Handler. It has to contain the correct information. (Only in case of Show Handling competitions for Juniors under 13 years and 13 and 17 years.)
2. The dog shows rules of the K.K.U.S.H. (Belgian kennel Club) are valid.
3. An entry-confirmation for the Show Handling competition must be shown.
4. Dogs refused for the dog show, it can't be entered in the Show Handling competition.
5. Dogs that can't be controlled by the Show Handler, or are a menace to the other competitors won't be allowed to enter the Show Handling competition.
6. The judge will be appointed by the organisation of the dog show, in co-operation with the J&S Show Handling Club. Decisions made by the judge can't be argument.
7. It is allowed to leave the ring in case the dog has to be judged in the breed show. Before leaving the ring, the steward must be warned. It is also allowed to re-enter the ring after the breed judging is done. The steward must be warned before entering the ring. Dogs may be switched, if needed.
8. Subscriptions are open for:
 - 8.1. Show Handling competitions for Juniors.
 - 8.1.1. Show handlers under 13 and between 13 and 17 years.
 - 8.2. Show Handling competitions for Junior and Senior.
 - 8.2.1. Show Handlers under 13, between 13 and 17 years, 18 and 40 years and over 40 years.
 - 8.3. Show Handling Team Matches.
 - 8.3.1. Show Handlers under 13, between 13 and 17 years, 18 and 40 years and over 40 years.
9. All Show Handlers return on time to the ring after the pre-selections.
 - 9.1. Two exceptions can be made.
 - 9.1.1. The Show Handlers dog is in the breed judging ring at that time. Only the Show Handler is expected at the Show Handling ring (without the dog.) The dog will be brought by a third party to the Show Handling ring when needed.
 - 9.1.2. The Show Handler is presenting the dog in the breed judging ring at that time. The Show Handler is expected to warn the Show Handling steward in time. The Show Handler will be allowed to enter the Show Handling ring on a later time. If selected, the Show Handler will be placed in the right place between the other selected Show Handlers.
10. To be allowed to the junior ranking, the Show Handlers:
 - 10.1. In case of Junior Show Handlers under 13 years and between 13 and 17 years.
 - 10.1.1. Must be member of the J&S Show Handling Club. The contribution must be done before the first competition of that year.
11. To be allowed to the senior ranking, the Show Handlers:



- 11.1. In case of Senior Handlers and between 18 and 40 years and over 40 years.
 - 11.1.1. Must be member of the J&S Show Handling Club. The contribution must be done before the first competition of that year.
12. Next of kin from the judge or co habitants are prohibited to enter the completions judged by this judge.
13. The J&S Show Handling Club can not be put responsible for any kind of damage, caused or could be caused, directly or indirectly by participating in the Show Handling Competition.
14. In case of discussion over these rules, the board of the J & S Show Handling Club will descried which measurements should take place. About the judging and ranking will no discussion be allowed.
15. Junior and Senior ranking.
 - 15.1. The show Handling Competition for Junior Show Handlers under 13 and between 13 and 17 years.
 - 15.1.1. The six best Junior Show Handlers from each competition obtain points for the junior ranking.
 - 15.1.2. First place gains 11 points, second place 9 points, third place 7 points, fourth place 5 points, fifth place 3 points, sixth place 1 point.
 - 15.2. The Show Handling Competition for Junior Show Handlers and Senior Show Handlers.
 - 15.2.1. The six best Junior Show Handlers and the six best Senior Show Handlers from each competition obtain points for the year ranking.
 - 15.2.2. First place gains 11 points, second place 9 points, third place 7 points, fourth place 5 points, fifth place 3 points, sixth place 1 point.
 - 15.3. The Show Handling Team Match for Junior Show Handlers and Senior Show Handlers.
 - 15.3.1. The six best Junior Show Handlers and the six best Senior Show Handlers from each competition obtain points for the year ranking. The points will be given to Junior Show Handlers as well as to Senior Show Handlers.
 - 15.3.2. First place gains 11 points, second place 9 points, third place 7 points fourth place 5 points, fifth place 3 points, sixth place 1 point.
 - 15.3.3. The two best Teams of Junior Show Handlers, and the two best Teams of Senior Show Handlers can gain points for the year ranking. The points will be given to Junior Show Handlers as well as to Senior Show Handlers. Those points will be added to previous gained points.
 - 15.3.3.1. The Show Handler of the best Team, with the highest score in that Team will gain 11 points, the Show Handler of the best Team, with the second-highest score in that Team will gain 9 points, the Show Handler of the best Team, with the lowest score in that Team will gain 7 points, the Show Handler of the second-best Team, with the highest score in that team will gain 5 points, the Show Handler of the second-best Team, with the second-highest score in that Team will gain 3 points, the Show Handler of the second-best Team, with the lowest score in that Team will gain 1 point.
 - 15.3.3.2. The same points will be given to the best and second-best Senior Show Handling Teams.



- 15.4. The “JUNIOR HANDLER OF THE YEAR” is:
- 15.4.1. The Junior Handler with the ten highest points in the Junior rankings.
 - 15.4.2. The Junior Handler must be of the Belgian or of Luxemburg’s nationality.
 - 15.4.3. The Junior Show Handler may not represent another country in Great Britain (Cruft’s)
 - 15.4.4. The Junior Show Handler must be a member of the J&S Show Handling Club. The contribution must be done before the first competition of that year.
 - 15.4.5. To be obtain the price, given by our sponsor, the Show Handler must be a client of this sponsor. If the competitor is not a client, the J & S Handling Club will give an alternate price, financed by the J & S Show Handling Club.
- 15.5. The “SENIOR HANDLER OF THE YEAR” is:
- 15.5.1. The Senior Handler with the highest points in the Senior rankings.
 - 15.5.2. The Junior Show Handler must be a member of the J & S Show Handling Club. The contribution must be done before the first competition of that year.
